- **C.** Discuss the demolition of the mill house and superintendent house at Hawks Creek Golf Course. (On December 13<sup>th</sup> both the Golf and Parks Committee and City Council approved both demolitions.)
  - Ms. Barrett reported the buildings had been demolished and showed photos of demolition sites and answered questions from the committee.
- **D.** Discuss the food and beverage department finances at Hawks Creek Golf Course.
  - Ms. Barrett answered questions from the committee regarding the financial status of the Hawks Creek food and beverage department, and relayed the progress made in the department since the arrival of Head Pro Wes O'Banion.

  - Ms. Barrett provided the committee with a briefing and answered questions, regarding the F-18 jet donation from the NASJRB, including some preliminary cost estimates on it and the T-33 currently in the park.

## **Summary/Overview**

- **WEATHER:** The weather for December was very mild contributing to a record-breaking month.
- **FINANCE:** 2763 rounds were played last month equating to a total revenue of \$184,033. Our new rate structure, course conditions, and weather helped contribute to the record-breaking month.
- **Golf Course Update:** The pro shop was burglarized on December 23rd in the early hours. The stolen items mainly included our high-end Titleist golf balls. Thankfully, no injuries occurred, but we did experience product loss and property damage. Police reports and insurance claims have been filed.
- **Resident usage:** This month there were 48 rounds were played by residents.
