## A Message from Mayor Jones

I am both honored and humbled to serve as your mayor.

First, I congratulate John Davies for an outstanding campaign. It's my challenge to earn the confidence of his supporters, as I will be a mayor for the entire city.

I promised to involve more people in city governance, and I will keep that promise. Within the last few days, I have appointed eight fresh voices to the city's boards, committees, and commissions, all of whom live in the original village.

We are already at work addressing your problems. The new Public Safety Committee has been tasked with addressing 1) the traffic problems on Koldin Lane, and 2) the alley visibility problems in the 5800 blocks. The invigorated Ordinance Advisory Board has been tasked with finding a reasonable solution to the current prohibition against adding on to existing homes without abiding by the more stringent new home construction standards.

The Westworth Village Water Department would like to remind citizens of the many services that we offer for their convenience.

### Paperless Billing

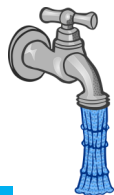
In an effort to become greener and to provide our residents with the most accessible and convenient experience, we offer paperless billing through email. In order to opt-in for this service, please access the application online at <http://cityofwestworth.com/utility> or at the Water Department window at City Hall.

### Online or Draft Payment

The City accepts automatic payments from banking institutions or credit cards. Residents still receive a bill via their preferred method, either mail or email, but the payment will be automatically drafted from their account on the due date every month. ### Eye on Water

The city's Public Works Department has been hard at work successfully upgrading all residential meters to smart meters. These meters allow residents to monitor their water consumption on a daily basis using the program EyeOnWater. It can be accessed here: <https://www.eyeonwater.com/signin> This system eliminates the need for manual meter reading every month, but also monitors possible water leaks on the homeowner's side of the waterline and can notify them of a possible leak by email.
