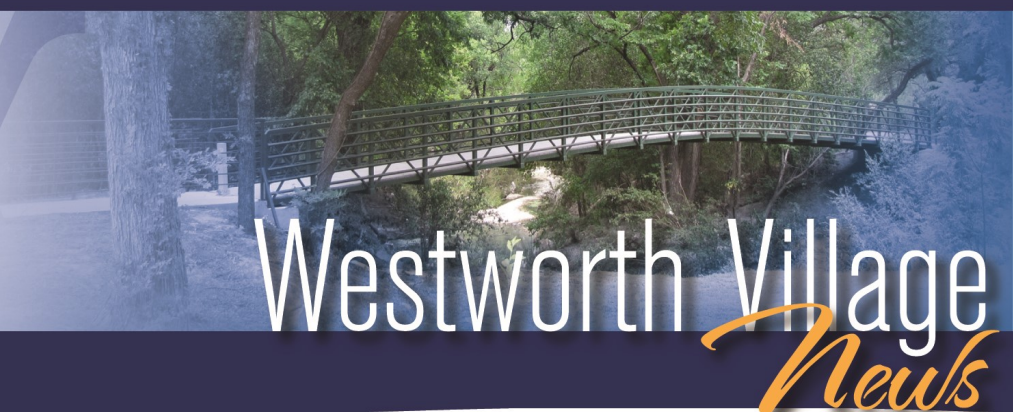

Letter from the Mayor

Fellow Citizens:

The six-year trail project continues to move toward completion. By the time you receive this letter, the contractor will likely have already commenced construction, beginning on the city's eastern boundary and moving slowly westward.

With the council's concurrence, we moved back the commencement date for the Leonard Oaks' and Fairways' portion of the trail until September 11th, giving us more time to address Fairways' residents' concerns about the trail project. During this interim, I pledge to make myself, Chief Reaves, City Administrator Naron, and the entire staff available to meet with homeowners of The Fairways, to listen and obtain their input and ideas to constructively address their concerns.

Interested citizens are invited to attend the new public safety committee's meeting at city hall on Thursday, August 1st, at 6:30, as an agenda item is "Presentation of Trail System Safety Plan" by Chief Reaves.

Working together, I know we will make the best final decisions for the residents of this city, the personnel at NAS Fort Worth JRB, and the entire region.

Annual Fall Clean-Up

The annual Fall Clean-Up and Environmental Waste Day for the city will be held in the Municipal Complex Parking Lot:

- **Saturday, September 21, 2019**
- **Fall Clean Up - Trash Only - 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM**
- **Environmental Waste — 9 AM to 11 AM**
- **Remember to bring proof of residency (copy of water bill or drivers license).**

During the Environmental Waste Clean-Up hours, acceptable items will include those that are harmful to the environment (i.e. paint, oil, batteries, etc.). However, we cannot accept needles or medical waste. Old prescriptions can always be dropped off in the drop-box located in the Police Department lobby.

During the remainder of the event, we will be unable to accept items harmful to the environment including refrigerators, freezers, or air conditioners.
