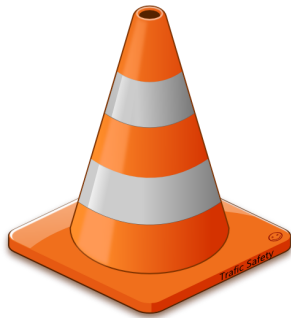

## Alleyway Directions



Council took action at the August 13<sup>th</sup> meeting to change the directions and signage of all developed alleyway travel to enter on the east and exit on the west in order to increase the safety of pedestrians and motorists. On **Saturday, September 7<sup>th</sup>**, the Public Works staff will be temporarily closing each alleyway and changing the directional signs. Once this has been completed, *effective immediately*, all

alleyways will be entered onto from Tanny Street and exit onto Seymour Lane (traveling east to west).

## Annual Fall Clean-Up

The annual Fall Clean-Up and Environmental Waste Day for the city will be held in the Municipal Complex Parking Lot:

- **Saturday, September 21, 2019**
- **Fall Clean Up - Trash Only - 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM**
- **Environmental Waste — 9 AM to 11 AM**
- **Remember to bring proof of residency (copy of water bill or drivers license).**

During the Environmental Waste Clean-Up hours, acceptable items will include those that are harmful to the environment (i.e. paint, oil, batteries, etc.). However, we cannot accept needles or medical waste. Old prescriptions can always be dropped off in the drop-box located in the Police Department lobby.

During the remainder of the event, we will be unable to accept items harmful to the environment including refrigerators, freezers, or air conditioners.

# Budget & Tax Rate

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that public hearings will be held by the City of Westworth Village City Council on September 10, 2019 at 7:00 pm, AND on September 24, 2019, at 6:00 pm, in the Council Chambers located at 311 Burton Hill Road, Westworth Village, Texas.

These hearings are held in compliance with Section §102.0065 of the Texas Local Government Code to receive input regarding the following items:

**The adoption of the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Budget:** The proposed budget will raise more total property taxes than last year's budget by \$178,905.

**The adoption of the 2019 Tax Rate** of \$0.475 per \$100 of valuation with the proposal to increase total tax revenues from properties on the tax roll in the preceding tax year by 4.35%. Your individual taxes may increase or decrease at a greater or lesser rate, depending on the change in the taxable value of your property in relation to the change in taxable value of all other properties and the tax rate that is adopted.

## LEGAL NOTICE, CITY OF WESTWORTH VILLAGE

### Statement of Increase/Decrease

IF the City of Westworth Village adopts a 2019 tax rate equal to the effective tax rate of \$.4459 per \$100 of value, taxes would increase compared to 2018 taxes by \$89,492.
