ORDINANCE NO. 440

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WESTWORTH VILLAGE MODIFYING CHAPTER 13, UTILITIES, SECTION 13.02.035 AND APPENDIX A, FEE SCHEDULE SECTION A6.004; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE CUMULATIVE OF ALL ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Westworth Village (the "City") is a Type A General Law city located in Tarrant County Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it is necessary and advisable to amend the City's Code of Ordinances to protect the safety and welfare of the general public, by modifying the utility ordinance and associated fee schedule for terminating and restoring utility services.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTWORTH VILLAGE, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1. Chapter 13: Utilities, of the Westworth Village Code of Ordinances, is hereby amended, by replacing Section 13.02.035 Terminating and Restoring Utility Services to read as follows:

"Sec. 13.02.035 Terminating and restoring utilities services

- (a) Utilities services will be terminated and restored in accordance with this article and city utility department policies. A Service Fee will be added to accounts when a service order is issued to have service terminated; restoration of services will only be done after the account is paid in full. A request for service restoration must be initiated by the account holder. Any fees associated with the termination or restoration of utility services will be stated on the city fee schedule.
- (b) When services are terminated for any reason, the city administrator shall make or cause to be made an investigation of the circumstances and, if required, may issue citations for the accumulation and storage of refuse and disposition of wastewater in order to protect the health, welfare and well-being of the citizens."

Section 2. The Fee Schedule, Appendix A of the Westworth Village Code of Ordinances, is hereby amended, by replacing Article A6.00 General Provisions, Section A6.004 to read as follows:

"Sec. A6.004 Terminating and restoring utilities services (Sec. 13.02.035)

- (a) Service Fee: \$25.00
(b) Service restoration fee: No charge"

Section 3. This ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of ordinances and of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Westworth Village, Texas, as amended, except where the provisions of this ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of such ordinances and such Code, in which event the conflicting provisions of such ordinances and such Code are hereby repealed.

Section 4. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction; such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance, since the same

would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.


Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law, and it is so ordained.


