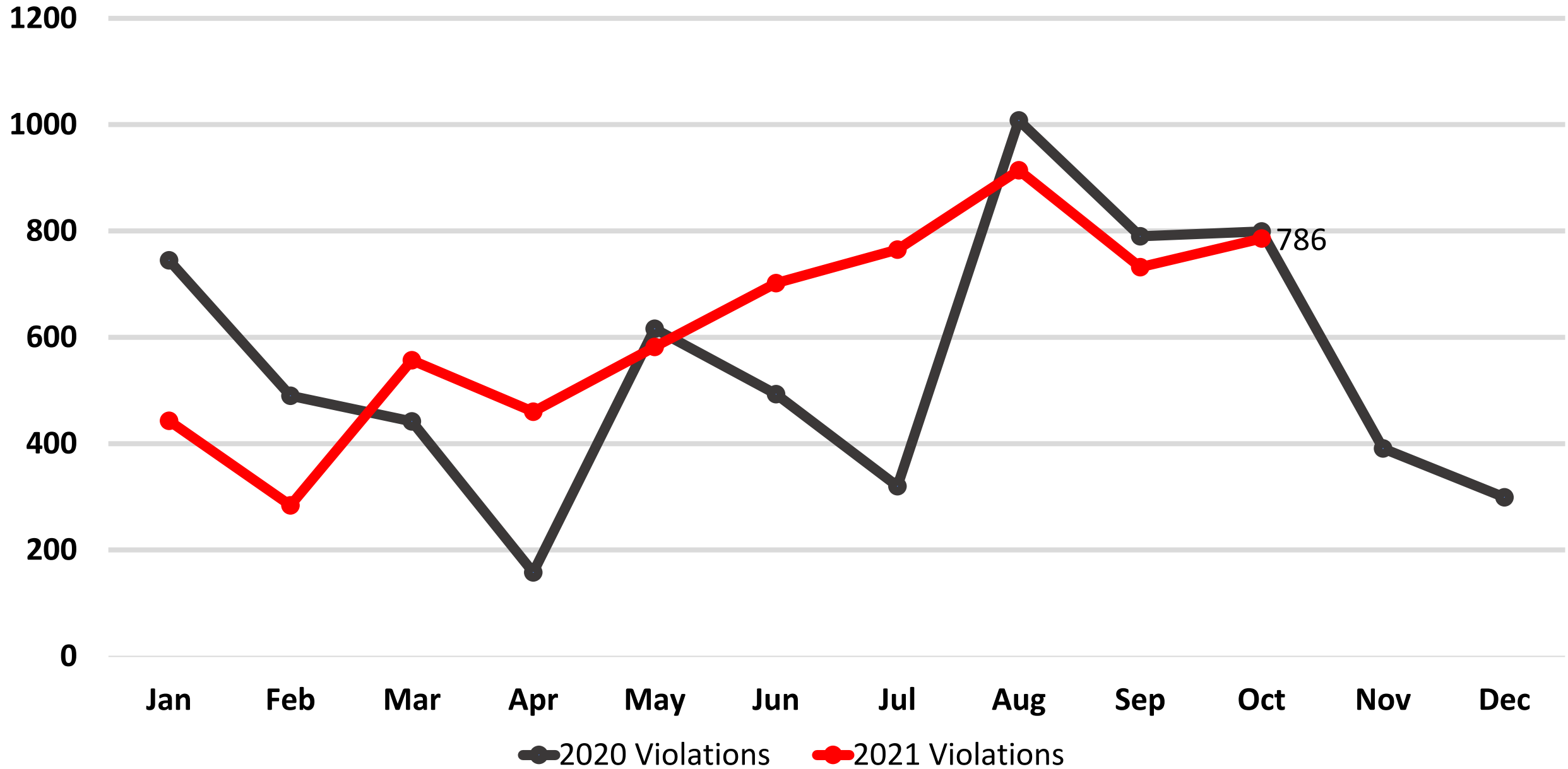

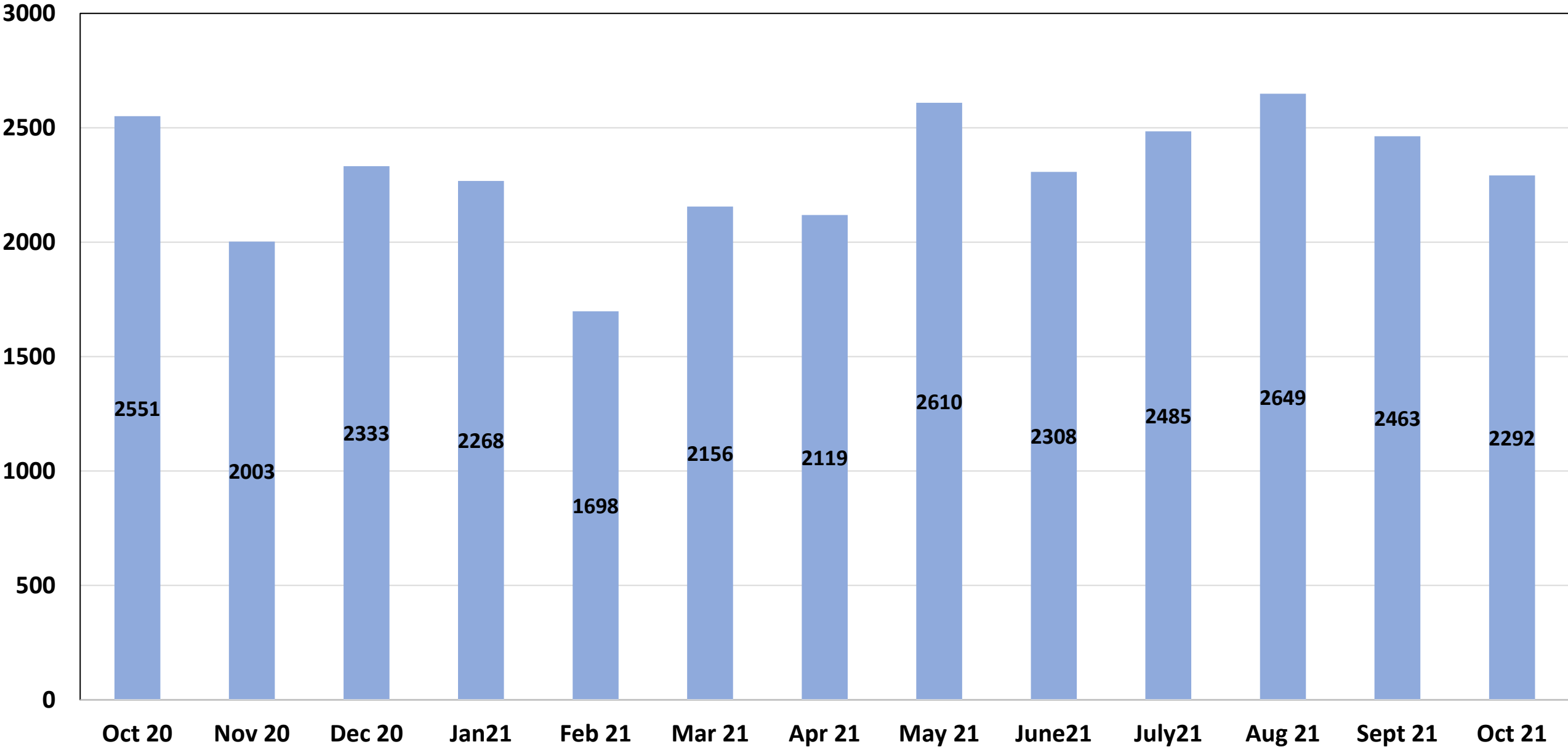

Number of Violations per Month

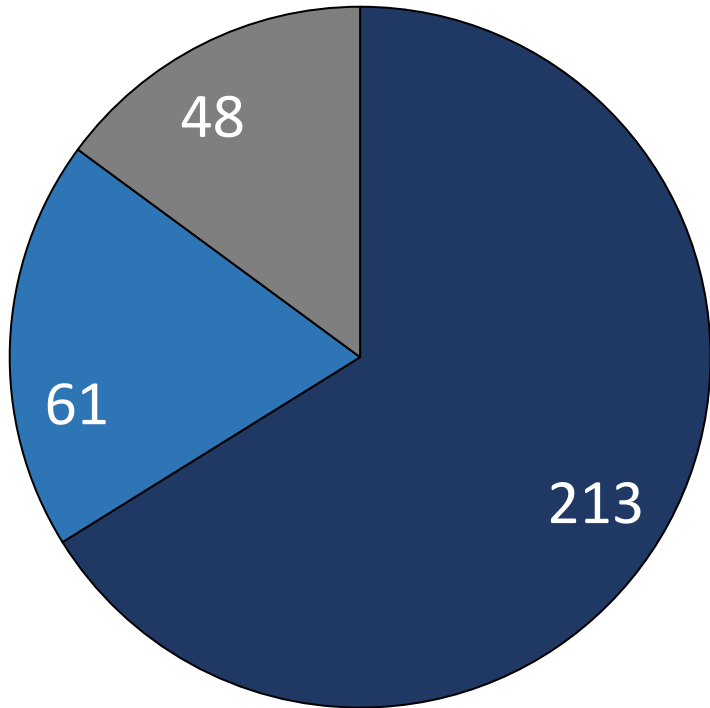


Total Calls for Service



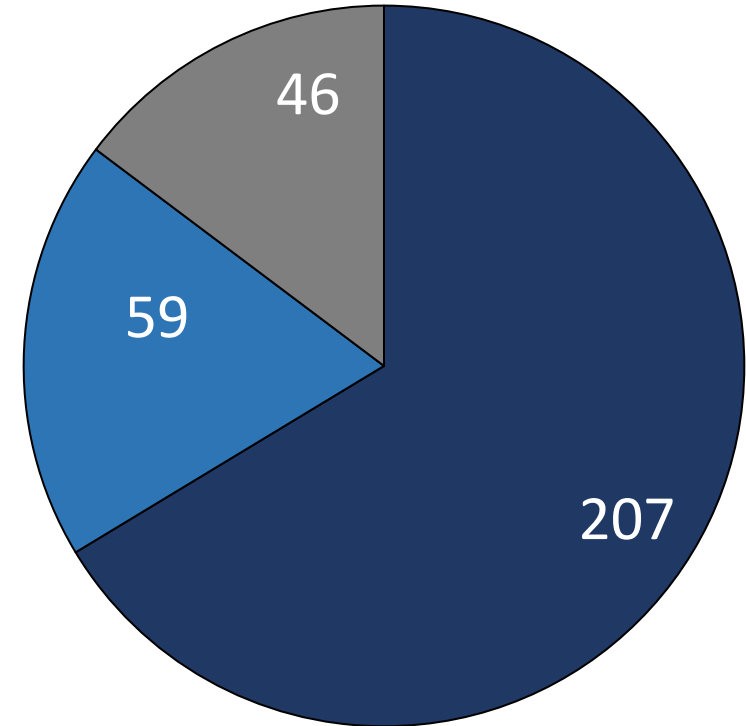
Charges Resulting From Arrests Summary

OCTOBER Year to Date 2020



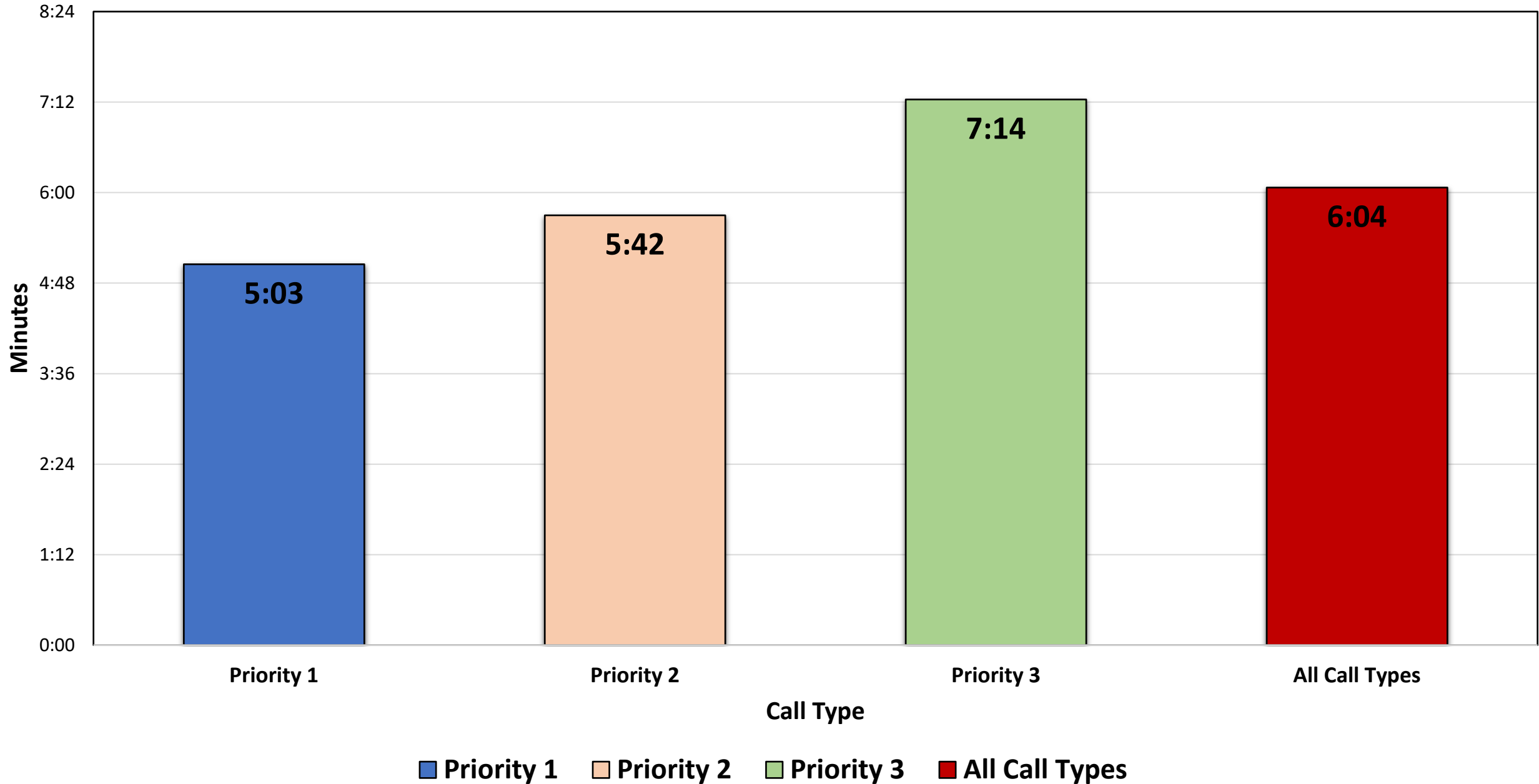

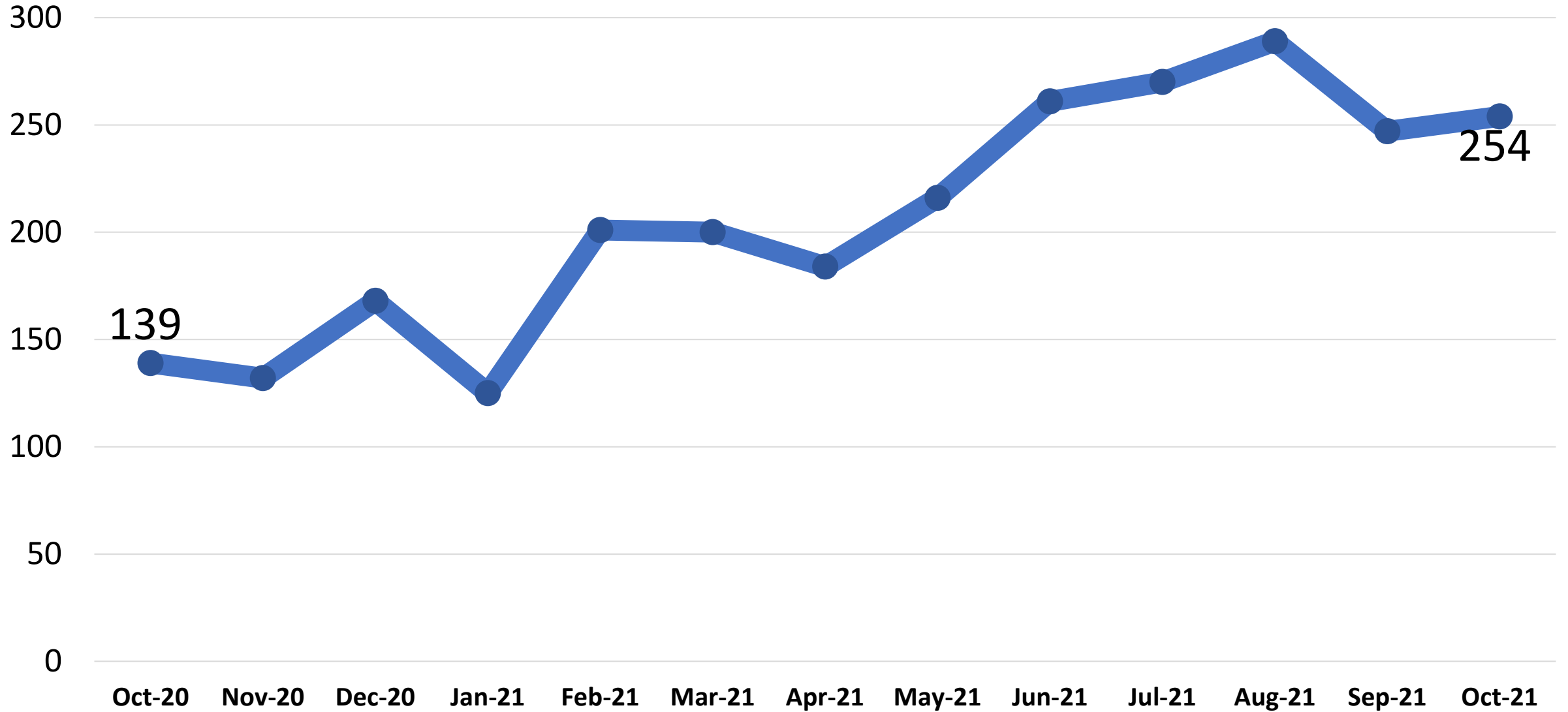
OCTOBER 2021 Response Times



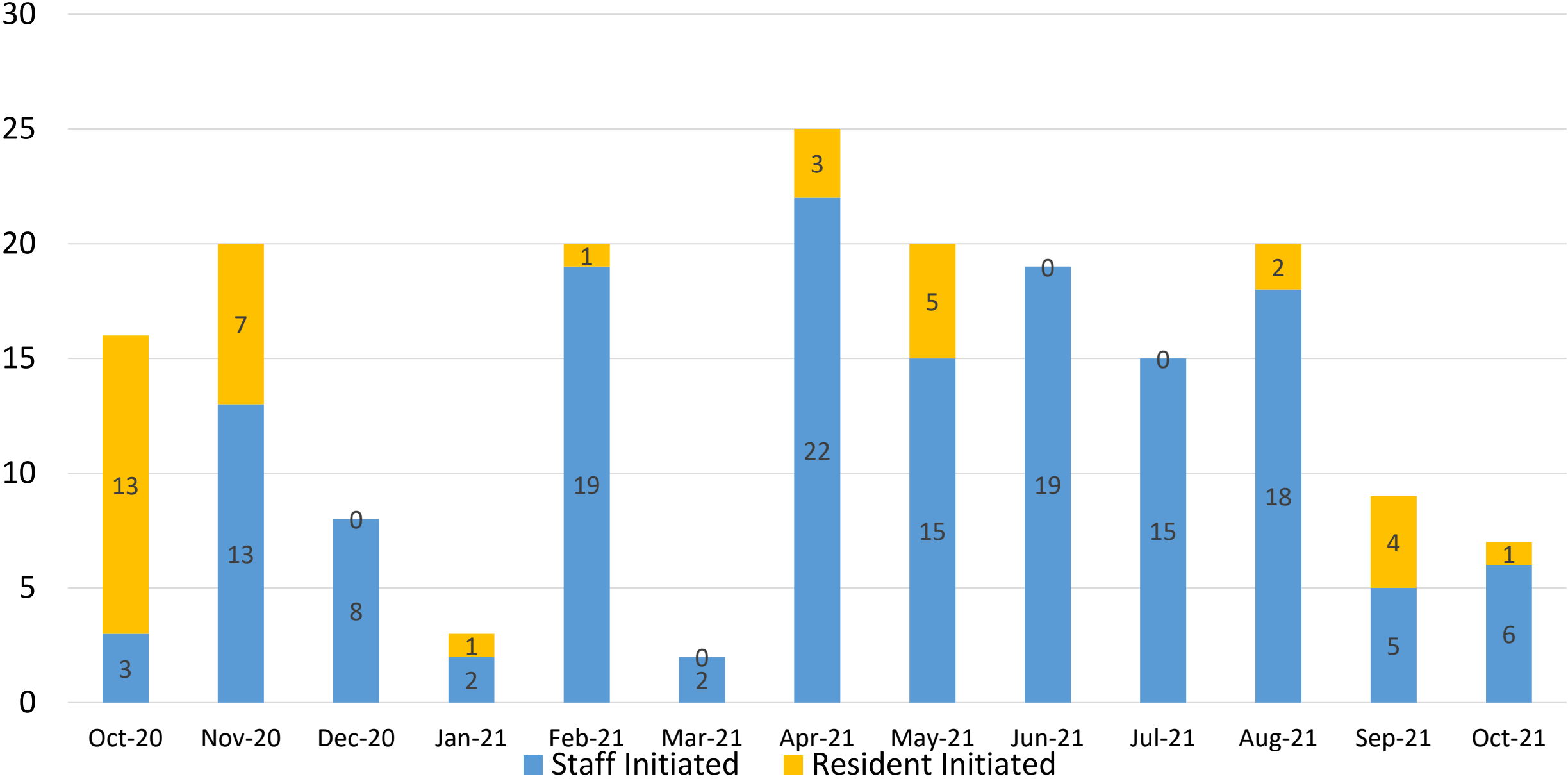
