CITIZEN COMMENTS

- Brian Libbey (5853 Straley Ave) was concerned about the \$30,000 consulting fee and wondered if it was necessary or if the City or citizens could purchase and install equipment themselves. He questioned what the ramifications would be if the City did not use the engineering firm.
- Abraham Elizondo (5733 Sunset) suggested designating the land behind City Hall as a public park and giving it a name rather than referring it to the "green space behind City Hall," to give the park a start.

- Katherine Utecht (Kimley Horn) introduced herself and the team that has been assigned to work on the City's park plan. She discussed the plan to focus on a passive park in front of City Hall and an active park in the green space behind City Hall. She discussed the timeline and methodology that will be employed for each step of the project. She answered several questions from the committee members.
