He explained that this was expected by staff and while a spending freeze has not been implemented, expenses must be approved and staff is mindful of the situation.

  - Sterling Naron reviewed in detail the preliminary budget for General Fund Revenue, Administration, Facilities, Fire Protection and Prevention Services, Court and Other Services. He noted that as previously directed all of his preliminary FY 2018-2019 budgets will be built on the assumption that the

Westworth Redevelopment Authority will take over all parks and recreation, including the golf course, library and lawn, landscaping and road side maintenance.

• Chairman Beckman reminded everyone that this is a process designed to review the preliminary budget in sections and Finance Committee will review it as a complete budget before it is submitted to Council for approval.
