He also noted that there were no issues with distances from schools or restricted areas and that Marley Phillips, with Creighton Development was present to answer any questions. - **D.** Discuss and take action regarding the Specific Use Permit for three outdoor kiosks to sell propane, ice and DVD rentals, requested by 7-Eleven, located in the Shoppes of Hawks Creek, at 6410 Westworth Blvd, Westworth Village, Texas.
 - Sterling Naron reviewed the request from 7-Eleven, providing pictures of other 7-Elevens in the area with outdoor kiosks. He reported that the design standards of the Shoppes at Hawks Creek, although silent on the issue of kiosks, did regulated the look of clean lines and uniformity, as proposed the kiosks do not meet this expectation. In addition, he reported that Ice and DVD rentals can be positioned inside the store like other business, however Fort Worth Fire said that the propane must be outside and a minimum of 10 feet from building entrances. He went on to say that staff does not support the approval of kiosks, as the disadvantages are greater than the advantages, including safety concerns, reducing sidewalk space, and increased collection points for trash and debris. He again noted that Marley Phillips, with Creighton Development was present to answer any questions.
 - Riley Peveto agreed that the having clean lines and an overall look was important in the shopping center.

• Melva Campbell agreed with the safety concerns.

MOTION to recommend council denial of the Specific Use Permit for three outdoor kiosks to sale propane, ice and DVD rentals, requested by 7-Eleven, located in the Shoppes of Hawks Creek, at 6410 Westworth Blvd, Westworth Village, Texas.
