- A. Approval of the minutes from the October 3, 2019 meeting.

- B. Discuss and take action on alleyway entrance/exit points, to improve visibility.
 - Following a brief discussion on the issues being addressed based on survey comments, it was the committee's request that Ms. Barrett provide education to the residents in the December newsletter. The information should include the current ordinance requirements and example photos. It was also recommended that individuals who have issues with code violations, such as alleyway obstructions, should contact the city as soon as they can so the issue can be addressed. Mr. Yeager requested the chair let the item lay until the survey results were final and a proper course of action could be determined.
 - No action was taken on this item, as it will be addressed as part of the survey results.
- **C.** Discuss and take action on the signal warrant study agreement for the intersection of Carb and Roaring Springs Road.
 - Sterling Naron reviewed the proposal submitted by Kimley Horn to complete a signal warrant study for the intersections of Roaring Springs and Carb, as well as Seymour/Coleman Lane. The study will include data collection, traffic signal warrant analysis, and documentation. The proposal for this service costs \$5000.00.

MOTION to recommend the council authorize Kimley Horn to perform a signal warrant study at the Roaring Spring Road and Carb and Seymour/Coleman.
