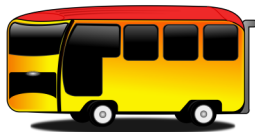
BUDGET AND TAX RATE

TRANSPORTATION

The City of Westworth Village has renewed their contract with FWTa (Fort Worth Transportation Authority) and the “T” and TCTS (Tarrant County Transportation Services). This contract makes Westworth Village a participating community and the qualifying residents of Westworth Village will be entitled to ride TCTS for a one way trip fare of \$2.50. Please keep in mind that this service picks you up from your home but only takes you to the closest stop to catch a bus or train.

Other options:

Catholic Charities: 817-336-8714 No charge for services. Service provided on Wednesday only. I spoke to a representative and they stated that services could be increased based on the demand. So call them and let them know that there is a demand.

MITS: 817-215-8600 Fee is \$3.25 one way and it operates under the same guidelines as the FWTa.

MHMR Tarrant: 682-587-7099 This service is a resource guide to finding additional services based on your needs both financially and your location.

LogistiCare: 855-687-3255 This is a service for Texas Medicaid and CSHCN clients. Your plan will cover the cost of the service. Please keep in mind that this service is for doctor appointments only. Your medical provider can call too to request service.
