The City of Westworth Village Code of Ordinances – Sec. 13.02.095

Damaging or tampering with meters

If anyone damages a meter, curbstop, or other related equipment owned by the city utilities department, they shall be responsible for payment of replacement costs of the equipment, plus a service charge for installation of the equipment. If you are doing repairs and need your water shut off, contact Public Works to turn off your service and avoid damaging the water meter or automatic meter reporting equipment.
