Free Sprinkler Evaluations

The Tarrant Regional Water District has partnered with M&M Irrigation to offer a free sprinkler evaluation to residents. After the evaluation, residents will receive a customized irrigation schedule which will provide specific recommendations on how to best maintain their lawn while being as efficient as possible with their water and sprinkler use.

If you would like to receive a **free** sprinkler evaluation and customized irrigation schedule, follow these steps:

1. Requests a sprinkler evaluation through:

2. You will be redirected to the M&M signup page to enter your information.
3. Someone from M&M Irrigation will contact you to set a date and time for the evaluation.
4. The sprinkler evaluation will take about 45 minutes, and the homeowner must be present during the evaluation.
5. Michael will walk you through the results of the evaluation and make recommendations to improve system efficiency.
6. You will receive a report showing the results of their evaluation, as well as a new customer irrigation schedule designed for your yard.

Budget & Tax Rate

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that public hearings will be held by the City of Westworth Village City Council on September 12, 2017 at 7:00pm, AND on September 26, 2017, at 6:00pm, in the Council Chambers located at 311 Burton Hill Road, Westworth Village, Texas.

These hearings are held in compliance with Section §102.0065 of the Texas Local Government Code to receive input regarding the following items:

The adoption of the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Budget: The proposed budget will raise more total property taxes than last year's budget by \$11,737.

The adoption of the 2017 Tax Rate of \$.50 per \$100 of valuation with the proposal to increase total tax revenues from properties on the tax roll in the preceding tax year by 10.78%. Your individual taxes may increase or decrease at a greater or lesser rate, depending on the change in the taxable value of your property in relation to the change in taxable value of all other properties and the tax rate that is adopted.

LEGAL NOTICE, CITY OF WESTWORTH VILLAGE

Statement of Increase/Decrease

IF the City of Westworth Village adopts a 2017 tax rate equal to the effective tax rate of \$.4571 per \$100 of value, taxes would increase compared to 2016 taxes by \$11,737.
