Speed Limit Reduction

REMINDER: Throughout the city, the speed limit on all city streets excluding alleyways, school zone on Burton Hill Road, Burton Hill Road, White Settlement Road East of Roaring Springs Road to the city limit, Roaring Springs Road, Pumphrey, and Highway 183/Westworth Blvd city limit to city limit, is being reduced to 25 miles per hour.

Signage has been placed on applicable streets. Please be mindful of this change and observe the new speed limits.

Sprinkler Information

With July and August being the hottest summer months, keeping the lawn watered can lead to higher than usual water bills. The TRWD has provided some tips for water conservation when it comes to lawn care:

- Don't water between 10 AM—6 PM
- Apply no more than an inch of water per week during summer
- Try to cycle and soak to avoid runoff by running zones in shorter bursts with one hour between cycles
- Turn your system off after a good rain
- Check your system regularly
