November Election

The City will hold a General Election on Tuesday, November 3, 2020. Early voting begins October 13th. The ballot will appear as follows:

- Place 2: Michael Dingman / Tiffany Aller
- Place 3: Brian Libbey / Phillip Poole
- Place 4: Abraham Elizondo, Unopposed
- Place 5: Dorenda Hendrix / Dani Briones

On the ballot, citizens will also be presented with the opportunity to vote on the reauthorization of the 1/4 cent street maintenance sales tax. This tax expires and must be voted on for reauthorization every four years. This tax does not affect personal property taxes unless voters choose not to reauthorize it.

This tax generates restricted revenue to fund Street Department equipment, maintenance supplies, and personnel.

Budget & Tax Rate

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that public hearings will be held by the City of Westworth Village City Council on September 8, 2020 at 7:00 pm, AND on September 15, 2020, at 5:30 pm, in the Council Chambers located at 311 Burton Hill Road, Westworth Village, Texas.

These hearings are held in compliance with Section §102.0065 of the Texas Local Government Code to receive input regarding the following items:

The adoption of the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Budget: The proposed budget will raise more total property taxes than last year's budget by \$220,013.

The adoption of the 2020 Tax Rate of \$0.475 per \$100 of valuation (no increase or decrease in the tax rate is proposed) the proposed rate will increase the total tax revenues collected by 6%, due to new properties being added to the tax role and changes in individual property values. Your individual taxes may increase or decrease, depending on the change in the taxable value of your property. Statement of Increase/Decrease

IF the City of Westworth Village adopts a 2020 tax rate equal to the no new revenue rate of \$.42850 per \$100 of value, tax revenue would increase compared to 2019 taxes by \$53,298.53.

Speed Limit Reduction

REMINDER: Throughout the city, the speed limit on all city streets excluding alleyways, school zone on Burton Hill Road, Burton Hill Road, White Settlement Road East of Roaring Springs Road to the city limit, Roaring Springs Road, Pumphrey, and Highway 183/ Westworth Blvd city limit to city limit, is being reduced to 25 miles per hour.
