November Election

The City will hold a General Election on Tuesday, November 3, 2020. Early voting begins October 13th. The ballot will appear as follows:

- Place 2: Michael Dingman / Tiffany Aller
- Place 3: Brian Libbey / Phillip Poole
- Place 4: Abraham Elizondo, Unopposed
- Place 5: Dore Hendrix / Dani Briones

On the ballot, citizens will also be presented with the opportunity to vote on the reauthorization of the 1/4 cent street maintenance sales tax. This tax expires and must be voted on for reauthorization every four years. This tax does not affect personal property taxes unless voters choose not to reauthorize it.

This tax generates restricted revenue to fund Street Department equipment, maintenance supplies, and personnel.

The closest early voting location for Westworth Village residents is the White Settlement Public Library located at 8215 White Settlement Rd.


Election Day voting will be held at the Westworth Village City Hall on November 3 from 7 AM - 7 PM.
