## **MedStar Saver Program**

A MedStarSaver membership is available to anyone who lives or works in the MedStar Service area (this includes all Westworth Village residents.) This membership can protect your entire household with unlimited emergency transports for the full year of your active membership for only \$69/ year if you have medical insurance, and \$110/ year if you do not. The membership covers any relative who permanently resides in your household, who is included in your application!

In addition to the benefits of the basic benefits. MedStarSaver+PLUS members get even more peace of mind through MedStar-On-Demand service. Specially trained community paramedics are on-duty, 24/7 to respond to your unscheduled. urgent medical needs. MedStarSaver+PLUS members also benefit from special options for care after a 911 medical call, such as enhanced treatment in place and referral options from the scene of a 911 call to prevent unnecessary emergency department visits. This enhanced program also covers all resident relatives in your household for \$350 annually.

When enrolling, use the Activation Code "StarSaver" to enroll in the basic membership program or "MedStarPLUS" to enroll in the MedStarSaver+PLUS enhanced MedStar on Demand membership program.

## **Water Conservation Tips**

As the summer heat approaches and chances of drought increase, here are some water conservation tips:

#### Indoors:

- Fix dripping faucets by replacing washers. One drop per second wastes 2,700 gallons of water a year.
- Check all plumbing for leaks and have any leaks repaired by a plumber.
- Choose appliances that are more energy and water efficient.
- Consider purchasing a low-volume toilet that uses less than half the water of older models.
- Never pour water down the drain when there may be another use for it. For example, use it to water your indoor plants or garden.

#### Outdoors:

- Position sprinklers so water lands on the lawn and shrubs and not on paved areas.
- Don't over-fertilize your lawn. Applying fertilizer increases the need for water. Apply fertilizers that contain slow-release, water-insoluble forms of nitrogen.
- Check sprinkler systems and timing devices regularly to be sure they operate
- Cover pools and spas to reduce water evaporation.
