If you need to dispose of hazardous waste at any time, please visit our Water Department to purchase a voucher to Fort Worth's Environmental Collection Center. Vouchers cost \$50 and you must bring your driver's license or current water bill with you for proof of residency.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

Budget & Tax Rate

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that public hearings will be held by the City of Westworth Village City Council on September 13, 2022 at 7:00 pm, AND on September 20, 2020, at 6:00 pm, in the Council Chambers located at 311 Burton Hill Road, Westworth Village, Texas.

These hearings are held in compliance with Section §102.0065 of the Texas Local Government Code to receive input regarding the following items:

The adoption of the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Budget: The proposed budget will raise more total property taxes than last year's budget by \$289,778.

The adoption of the 2022 Tax Rate of \$0.475 per \$100 of valuation (no increase or decrease in the tax rate is proposed) however, the proposed rate will increase the total tax revenues collected by \$39,310 due to new properties being added to the tax roll. Your individual taxes may increase or decrease, depending on the change in the taxable value of your property. IF the City of Westworth Village adopts a 2022 tax rate equal to the no new revenue rate of \$.384272 per \$100 of value, tax revenue would increase compared to 2021 taxes by \$177,634
